Based upon feedback from former timeshare owners at Caravanserai Resort, now renamed Alegria by its new owners, many American and Canadian owners of SXM timeshares think the government there likes the revenue it receives from North Americans but that it intends to do nothing about creating consumer protection for them. And for those timeshare owners, that perception is a cold, hard reality. (See our separate story about Caravanserai below.)

Based upon what we know, however, that conclusion is dead wrong....

Everything we are hearing about Tourism Minister Claret Connor from his close friends and from others who now work

with him or who have in the past says he is a man of genuine integrity. He knows the areas for which he is responsible, is very thorough, does his homework, can be relied upon to deliver on his promises, etc.

He must satisfy multiple constituencies including voters, the Parliament, consumers / tourists of course, and local businesses. He has many responsibilities and has been on the job only for a few months -- and government in SXM isn't built to deliver overnight results. But we do believe based on what we now know that he should be given the benefit of the doubt; our sense is that he really is trying to deliver.

We found out in the last few days that a Dutch side hotel with about 78 rooms has been taken over by a company from the US. We didn't think caravanserai resort was that small, so we set out to find which Dutch side resorts have 78 rooms. The answer: a few have about that number.

All we know so far is that that resort has been taken over by a US company. We don't know the name of the company or what they intend to do with the resort; we simply know that it has been taken over by a US company.

As always, we'll keep you posted when we learn more.

14. How a Cruise Passenger Saved \$46,000 on Vacation

Google "how to save money on travel" and you will literally get about 433,000,000 results in .37 seconds. Whether it's "being flexible with your travel dates" or "going directly to the airline website," there's one super hot tip that can —when you least expect it—save you thousands of dollars.

Just ask Gilbert Molnar, who was happily resting from a busy day aboard a luxury cruise ship in the Mexican Caribbean one night with his wife when a crushing pain woke him up in the middle of the night. A quick call to the onboard 911 medics revived him and kept him stable long enough for the ship to dock in Cozumel, where he was immediately transferred via ambulance to the Cozumel Medical Center.

That's when the rest of the nightmare began to play out: the Medical Center wanted USD \$25,000 up front. His wife was able to come up with \$5000 on a credit card, but that wasn't enough. After calls to their daughter and son-inlaw they were able to come up with an additional \$15,000—and the clinic settled for \$20,000. With a looming heart procedure costing even more money upfront, Gilbert's wife reached for the SkyMed membership card he had in his wallet.

15. Orient Beach Business Demolitions / Reconstruction Delayed Until June

In a story published here last winter, we reported that all of the Orient beach businesses from Pedro's to KonTiki were scheduled to be demolished starting in April in a \$2+million project planned by the Reserve Naturelle, which is responsible for the overall administration of Orient beach.

In that article, we reported that following the demolition, new construction would be erected where parking is now located behind the current structures. This would enhance the size of the beach and protect the structures somewhat from rising seas and storms. A new parking area is to be erected behind the new road which will be built behind the current parking area.

All of this was originally supposed to start this month, but — no surprise — it didn't. We're told that now, construction is scheduled for June and should be finished in two months.

As we understand it, all of the structures from Pedro's to but apparently not including KonTiki are in the line of fire. Some people are saying that Pedro's is not included but that KonTiki is included; we are still checking to be sure what we've reported is accurate.

It appears that some businesses won't move into the new facilities; that's up to the owners. Club Orient is not affected by this construction and rebuilding. We'll keep you posted when anything happens.

16. Why You Should Never Put Any Valuables In Your Suitcase

Even if you put valuables in a suitcase secured by TSA approved locks, they can still be opened without disturbing either the lock or the integrity of the suitcase. That fact is ample reason never to put any valuables in any suitcase that will be out of your sight.

No cameras, no jewelry, no prescriptions, no valuables whatsoever should ever go in suitcases....

17. Laptop Locks That Don't Work

Many laptop locks don't offer real protection against theft.

Today, the most widely sold laptop locks display four numbers. You set a combination, lock the system as directed, then move the knobs so the combination isn't visible.

Several years ago, many locks with <u>three</u> numbers stopped working -- either locking so they couldn't be unlocked (except with a hacksaw) or they opened without the combination being entered.

Use a lock with four numbers and use a program like GadgetTrak to track the location of your device should it be stolen (see www.gadgettrak.com). That particular program takes pictures of the thief and automatically emails them to an email address you select ever half hour or so. More important, it reports the exact location of the computer, enabling police to recover your stolen equipment. (Also works for smart phones.)

18. The Sargasso Seaweed Story

The Sargasso Sea is a large area of floating seaweed well east of Florida and south of Bermuda. You'll see it here: <u>http://www.daviddarling.info/encyclopedia/S/Sargasso_Sea.html</u> It contains sargassum seaweed (sometimes called sargasso seaweed) and last summer and fall, thanks to anomalies in ocean currents, climate change, and possibly to Gonzalo, a number of tons of errant sargassum seaweed wound up on the eastern shores of islands across the northern Caribbean, including SXM.

For whatever reason, Dawn Beach seemed to have the worst time, but front-end loaders dutifully picked the stuff up each morning and hauled it away. The seaweed, for as long as it was left at the edge of the beach, helped beaches rebuild after Gonzalo. It has other benefits as well; see <u>http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Sargasso_Sea</u>

There is some seaweed on some beaches now; the amount is <u>not</u> disruptive. We'll report on it as necessary going forward.

19. Are Five New Hotels Coming? Cay Bay, Harbor, Simpson Bay, Alegria,

Starz

Could be ...

First, Indigo Bay, slowed by the Great Recession, is going full speed ahead now, with much new construction all winter long. Their Master Plan originally called for a new boutique hotel not far north of the new restaurant that's now under construction. It wouldn't surprise us to see something getting going there in about two years. The location is Cay Bay. (We've sent a note to the developer about this.)

Second, we wrote in recent weeks about the resort hotel now approved for the Great Bay Harbor area. It will be done in about two years, authorities have said.

Third, the Seminole Tribe, when it was planning to buy Simpson Bay Resort, proposed building a casino and business condo complex at the location of the current casino / restaurant area in the "hole" of the Simpson Bay doughnut. It strikes us that that could well happen without the Seminoles. There is room, there is an absolute need (especially with a convention center), and we know the money is available. Our guess, something will happen between 2018-2020, though at this point it's only an educated guess.

Fourth, Caravanserai was bought by a US company and was renamed Alegria. Its winter business was apparently not so hot, but they may have been prepared for that. Something will happen here, although it may not wind up being exactly what the investor, Ray Sidhom, had in mind when he bought it. This will be interesting.

Fifth, Starz Casino, formerly Atlantis, has had a long-range plan to replace the existing structure with something complete new possibly including a highrise condo hotel. Francesco Corallo, owner, does have some other issues to deal with, so we're not sure when this might happen, or "if." 20. Why There Are No Tolls on the Simpson Bay Causeway

When the Causeway was opened, authorities said tolls would never have worked. Taxi drivers would have blocked access to the bridge, and others would have either avoided the bridge or evaded tolls. So a tax was added to every shipping container coming into port, raising the cost of everything -- and paying for the causeway.

21. What To Do If You Become Critically III or Injured in SXM

Your first thoughts might regard which hospital to go to -- French or Dutch. If only it were that simple....

The fact is that whichever hospital you go to, two things will be lacking: first, your health insurance is unlikely to cover any part of your care, and second, neither hospital compares favorably to most big-city hospitals in the US or Canada. Even worse, the doctors in SXM won't have (or get) your medical records expeditiously, which means they may have to guess what to do -- if, in fact, they can do it at all.

What you need to do is get home, if you are stable enough to be transported. If you're critically ill or injured, that may necessitate a medical evacuation jet which you must pay for in cash, in advance. that could easily be \$45,000 or more.

22. What Kind of Car Should You Rent?

It's not an unimportant question.

If you're in SXM at the height of hurricane season and will be here for a couple of weeks or more, an SUV may be a bright idea. They can get through streets with some vegetation debris or some standing water in case a tropical storm swaggers through.

If you have kids, you want to be sure your vehicle has airbags and child seats (not all cars do).

Otherwise, be sure you rent something big enough to protect you in a crash (a "Smart" car isn't necessarily the smartest pick for your safety) and that delivers economical performance, since gas in SXM is still far pricier than it is in the USA or Canada.

24. Should You Stay Longer in SXM?

For many people, the idea of staying longer in SXM is highly alluring. But various things interfere like job, home, family, etc.

Yet a steadily increasing number of people are actually doing it. Growing kids, the ability to work remotely, and affordability are big reasons.

If your timeshare maintenance fee or hotel bill is upwards of \$1200 / week, that does not exclude you from spending more time in SXM. Specifically, there are good rentals on the island that can be had for under \$2K/month (roughly \$500/week). Drive around the Dutch Side -- Beacon Hill and Cupecoy for example -- and you'll see real estate agents advertising both seasonal and monthly rentals.

So if your family or job situation allows it, you may just be able to pull it off like hundreds of others already have. It's far more doable than you may have imagined.

Stay less than six months in SXM, and the Dutch-American Friendship Treaty makes things easy. Stay longer, and it gets a bit more complicated, but it's still doable.

Decide whether you want to move to SXM or simply buy a second home or apartment there, or rent for a season or longer. Then, ask who the best real estate agents are; some are local, others are transplanted Americans who can easily give you the lowdown from your own perspective.

Move deliberately when fact-finding to be sure everything is crystal clear. Life in SXM isn't perfect, but with midwinter daytime highs of 82 and lows of 75 on a cool night, it's far better than "home" up north facing the frequent winter choice of which shovel to use to get the snow off the walk and your car unburied. And there's always the beach.
