

1. Hurricane Season Winding Down; "Ends" Nov. 30

Although the 2017 hurricane season technically ends 11/30, hurricanes have actually formed historically over most of the year. They're simply uncommon from December 1 through the end of May.

The 2017 hurricane season, of course, will go down in history as one of the most destructive ever. We're not going to say anything about what might happen in the last two and half weeks of the season. Suffice it to say that we're quickly closing in on the finish line and we, like you, hope the rest of the season is boring.

Our partner through all of this has been Crown Weather, <u>CrownWeather.com</u> headed by Rob Lightbown. Although on these pages you usually see the work that he does related to the tropics, Crown Weather also covers winter weather in the US very closely from its headquarters in Massachusetts. If your business can be affected by weather, sign on for Crown Weather's in-depth services; they're economical but incredibly valuable and useful.

2. Get Up-To-Date Tropical Outlooks, Watches, & Warnings

Major updates to the Weather section of our everythingSXM.com website were completed over the last few weeks.

In addition to many new real-time tropical weather graphics — including satellite images and new loops — our weather site has now been updated with the National Hurricane Center's latest tropical outlook; tropical weather discussion (for true weather geeks); and the latest forecasts, watches, and warnings for all active storms, plus new

As we've said before, if you are in the path of an approaching storm, never use any website for life or death advice: always rely on directives from local authorities.

You'll find detailed observations and forecasts by visiting our main SXM website, <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u>, and clicking either of the weather observations at the top of the page.

The four sources of current weather info, beyond the two above, are:

<u>Crown Weather Services</u> whose very inexpensive subscription service is, we feel, the best in the business.
Our "Weather" page at <u>www.everythingsxm.com</u> -- it has current satellite images and radar loops and now all the latest NHC weather forecasts, outlooks, and advisories as well.

3) Our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>, which publishes the latest advisories, watches, and warnings when SXM is threatened by any storms.

4) On or off the island, listen to Island 92 -- 91.9FM or see <u>www.island92.com</u>. They report island warnings at once and know exactly what's going on. You can listen on the web anytime through live streaming. They were knocked off the air by Irma but are now back.

Get a quick, current satellite look at the Atlantic basin anytime: <u>http://www.goes.noaa.gov/GIFS/ATWV.JPG</u> .

N. B.: Again...Never rely on any website if you're in the path of a storm; always heed warnings from local authorities.

5. Will That Billion Dollar Lawsuit Against Diamond Resorts Affect SXM Timeshare Owners?

During 2017, a billion-dollar class-action lawsuit was filed against Diamond Resorts International in Nevada, its home state.

As far as we can tell, the lawsuit remains active. Being aware of the suit, some timeshare owners at both Diamond Royal Palm Resort and Diamond Flamingo Resort have expressed concern to us about DRI's prognosis should it lose this lawsuit.Both resorts are closed until at least 2019 and possibly later, but they're still collecting annual maintenance fees according to their timeshare owners.

We've asked Amber Eck, one of the litigating attorneys for the plaintiffs, for her comment in response to this concern. She had not replied by press time.

At this point, the answer to the question in our headline is unclear.We're keeping an eye both on the lawsuit and on Diamond Resorts actions that may affect its timeshare owners in St. Maarten.

As always, we'll keep you posted. Here's more.

6. Simpson Bay Resort: Latest Updates

A source inside Simpson Bay Resort gave us the following updates:

- All of the debris at the resort, including the numerous wrecked cars that were in the vicinity of the of the B and C buildings, has been removed.
- The C and D buildings have been cleared out and all material that can be salvaged, including appliances, from all damaged units, has been removed and stored.
- All buildings, including C and D, should be fully assessed in the next 30 to 60 Days.
- Two new generators were delivered to the resort and installed.
- Air conditioning repair is ongoing for the large a/c units that serve the Villas building.
- Workers have started repairing the damaged roofs and the exterior hallways and walkways.
- The restaurants (La Patrona, Replay Sports Pub) are open and have been drawing people from around the island.

SXM Weekly News expects to hear more from SBR about all the topics you've asked about once the assessments have been completed. SBR is larger than many college campuses, and with the extreme demand on insurance adjusters and insurance companies, the assessments do take time. Nonetheless, the resort continues to work on

repairs.

When will Simpson Bay reopen? It had previously announced April but a source inside SBR told us this weekend: "It is not set in stone – if we can re-open sooner we will try to."

7. Correction: Bel Air Beach Resort To Open During March

We recently published an article which misstated the opening date for Bel Air Beach Resort. The resort tells us that it will be reopening during the month of March — as soon as they're ready.

8. Ocean Club Expected To Rebuild, But Few Members Know

Timeshare owners at Ocean Club in Cupecoy have been openly expressing frustration with Ocean Club owner Eric, who they say has given them very little information on the future of the resort.

Ocean Club was badly damaged by hurricane Irma. But Porto Cupecoy and Sapphire Beach Club, both nearby, had comparatively little damage, while Summit Resort Hotel which was built primarily with wood back in 1973 was demolished by Irma.

The difference is construction. Pictures of Ocean Club posted on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u> show wood in a lot of the walls. Clearly, wood was no match for the ferocity of killer category five hurricane Irma, which caused catastrophic damage across the island.

Built just before hurricane Luis hit the island in 1995, Sapphire beach club suffered comparatively little damage then. It had more serious damage from hurricane Irma, a far more powerful storm, but that damage was light compared to the utter destruction of wood buildings elsewhere on the island. Porto Cupecoy also survived remarkably well -- including its windows. Many windows used elsewhere weren't designed to withstand the forces exerted by major hurricanes.

<u>But back to Eric</u>. We are hearing from timeshare owners on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u> that Eric has told some of them that he does intend to rebuild. However, insurance assessments are continuing across the island and that is a slow process. We're sure that as soon as he knows exactly what will be involved to rebuild, how long it will take, and what if anything may be required financially from timeshare owners, he will let everyone know.

We continue to follow this as always and will keep you posted.

12. Dutch Side Parliament Throws Out Prime Minister Marlin

14. You May Owe a Big Thank You to Trinity Houston

Read this, regardless of the resort you were evacuated from after Irma:

"Simpson Bay Resort (SBR) was contacted by the US State Department to let SBR know there were a bunch of bags held in 'a secure area' at the airport. We had been previously advised that all of the bags left at the airport had been donated already, and that none were left, but apparently they just lost track of them for a little while. Anyway, Trinity Houston went to the Airport to retrieve luggage for SBR members, but it turned out there were hundreds of bags there that had been left behind by people from all over the island.

"On her own time, without pay, she took it upon herself to sort through the bags that are held in an area without airconditioning (and with a bunch of standing water, mosquitoes, etc.) and tracked down every single person she could find to arrange for their bags to be sent back to them (if they wanted the bag back; some people donated them). She did this for everyone, whether they were Simpson Bay Resort members or not...."

15. Top Carrot Is OK, Tropical Wave Isn't

The Top Carrot restaurant in Simpson Bay has reopened for business. It's the most popular place on the island for vegetarian/vegan food.

However the Tropical Wave restaurant on Le Galion Beach fared poorly, as you might expect: it was destroyed by hurricane Irma. But here's the *rest* of the story:

Patrick Turner has owned Tropical Wave for decades and his legendary tenacity won't by stopped by a stupid hurricane. His <u>Facebook Site</u> says "Tropical Wave will live on. Rebuild with the authorisation of certain departments underway. Be strong and Gofund me."

Go Patrick!

16. Dutch Side Ready For Tourists, French Side Not So Much

Two months plus one week is all that's passed since Irma nailed SXM.

This time, the Dutch Side has been highly dynamic in its recovery. The start was clumsy (not surprising seeing the catastrophic damage Irma caused), but they've been going flat out to clean up and get ready and have been notably successful.

The French Side is a different story. Grand Case Lolos are coming back, but action elsewhere is very slow. Insurance adjustment is one issue, previously ignored regulations are another. Those regulations may make it difficult for businesses facing Grand Case beach to rebuild.

On Orient, the Collectivite is saying it wants any new buildings to be capable of being packed up and removed when another big storm threatens - like trade show booths.

17. SXM Timeshare / Hotel Employees Still Need Your

Help

You will likely remember that more than 90% of all buildings on St. Maarten were at least damaged by category five hurricane Irma — and many were destroyed. The people of St. Maarten still need your help. It was found on a barrier island off Baton Rouge, Louisiana, within the last few weeks — and we want to find the person who launched it.

Here's the complete story from SXM Weekly News of a couple of weeks ago:

On a New Year's cruise off the waters of St. Maarten at the end of 2012, someone put a pen-written note in a whiskey bottle and threw it overboard.

Like many others who had thrown messages in bottles into the sea over the years, they likely figured they'd never hear about it again.

They were wrong, as they'll discover when --hopefully-- they read this story.

Mary Lynn saw a post in her Facebook timeline from Wyatt Webb, a friend who liked fishing in the coastal waters off Biloxi and Gulfport, Mississippi. Seems Wyatt saw something bobbing in the water and he retrieved it.

A small note inside the clear glass bottle was a bit smudged by water, but he could read clearly: "Happy New Year. 2012-2013 cruise St. Maarten. kusaxxxx@hotmail.com."

It was found in the Chandeleur islands in the Gulf of Mexico south of Biloxi and well east of New Orleans.

Thanks to Mary Lynn, a photo of the bottle and the note are on our <u>Everything St. Maarten Facebook Site</u>. We emailed two possible addresses for the bottle thrower, one of which was to a TV news department at KUSA in Colorado. We'll let you know what we hear -- nothing yet.

We don't know if many bottles survive such long trips -- this one was almost 3,000 km -- particularly when they're glass bottles in hurricane-battered areas. We've made contact with Wyatt and hope to have more on this soon.
